

If you're looking for choice and convenience, we've got a solution – our Added Choice® point-of-service (POS) plan. As an Added Choice member, you have access to all that Kaiser Permanente offers, plus the option to seek covered services from licensed providers across the country.

Available providers

Added Choice offers 3 levels of coverage. The choices you make determine which doctors you see, which medical facilities you use, and how much you pay.

SELECT PROVIDERS¹

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Choose a provider from Kaiser Permanente or direct contract providers, like The Portland Clinic.² With a referral, members can also choose other contracted community providers and facilities. You will typically have the lowest out-of-pocket costs when you receive services from select providers.

PPO PROVIDERS1

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Choose a preferred provider (PPO) from First Choice Health or First Health Network.³ This is a good choice for those who want to keep their current PPO provider or who live outside our service area.

NONPARTICIPATING PROVIDERS¹

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Choose a nonparticipating provider nationwide. Nonparticipating providers include any licensed providers who are not select providers or PPO providers. You will typically have the highest out-of-pocket costs when you receive services from nonparticipating providers.



If your Added Choice plan includes a pharmacy benefit,* you can fill your prescriptions at a Kaiser Permanente or MedImpact pharmacy. You will typically have a higher cost share when using a MedImpact pharmacy. You may be able to save time and money by using the mail-order pharmacy option.

Choose a doctor

You may choose a select provider, a PPO provider, or a nonparticipating provider. Your choice determines which health care providers you see, which medical facilities you use, and how much you pay. You may choose a different provider each time you get care.

NEW: 24/7 virtual care

Kaiser Permanente clinicians are available day or night, 24/7, for urgent care needs via ondemand video and phone, no appointment necessary.^{2,3,4}



Scheduled video or phone appointment

Schedule a face-to-face video visit or phone appointment with a Kaiser Permanente clinician or any specialists you've been referred to.^{2,3,4}



In-person care

We offer same-day, next-day, after-hours, and weekend services at many of our locations, including our Care Essentials by Kaiser Permanente retail clinics.^{4,5}



Email

Message your Kaiser Permanente doctor's office with nonurgent questions and get a reply usually within 2 business days.



Prescription delivery

Use the Kaiser Permanente app to fill most prescriptions for delivery or same-day pickup. Most members get a 3-month supply of medication for the price of 2, and shipping is free.⁶


